Results of a new test for Zika diagnosis are published

The new technique is more sensitive, faster and cheaper than real-time PCR and proved to be efficient in tests with mosquito samples. The results were published at Nature - Scientific Reports.

With a broad review of the scientific literature and more than 115 case studies, the book points out ways for the urban transformation needed to make cities more resilient and sustainable.

Internet and health in Brazil is book theme

Right to water: access to sanitation is not enough
