#### More than 120 complete arbovirus genomes are sequenced

In just 15 days, a project led by Fiocruz generated 126 complete virus genomes responsible for large outbreaks in the country, including 69 of dengue, 34 of chikungunya and 23 of zika.

#### Two new species of virus discovered in Brazil

Denoted as Xapuri and Aporé, in reference to the remote locations of Acre and Mato Grosso do Sul where they were located, the micro-organisms belong to the mammarenavirus genus of the arenavirus family.

#### President of Fiocruz takes part in a workshop in Rwanda

The meeting focused on how to accelerate research, development and innovation so the world can achieve the 2030 Agenda health targets, as part of WHO Global Action Plan.

#### Fiocruz participates in UN STI Forum for 2030 Agenda

The event brought together multiple stakeholders to identify and examine the needs and gaps in technology for the implementation of 2030 Agenda.
