Fiocruz formalizes alliance with WHO's Tropical Diseases Program



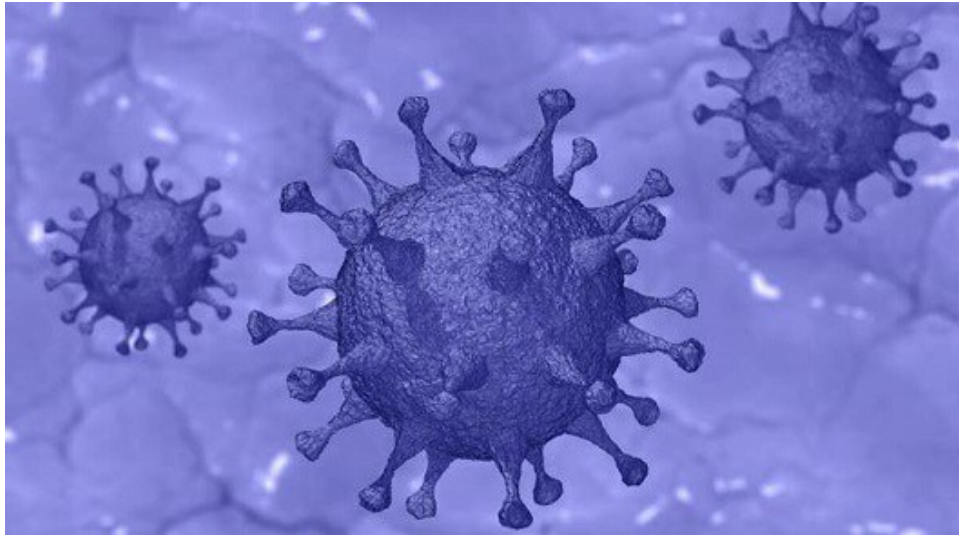
The document signed establishes the technical cooperation terms between Fiocruz and the Special Program for Research and Training in Tropical Diseases of the World Health Organization (TDR/WHO)

The British government wants to expand its scientific partnership with Fiocruz, especially in fields such as genomic sequencing, declared the minister counsellor of the British Embassy in Brazil, Melanie Hopkins

A research coordinated by Oxford University in the United Kingdom points out that the Pfizer and AstraZeneca vaccines, this one produced in Brazil by Fiocruz, also guarantee protection against infection with the Delta variant of COVID-19

A milestone of the foundation is related to national sovereignty. The manufacturing of the first pre-validation batch of the COVID-19 vaccine using the Active Pharmaceutical Ingredient (API) produced at Bio-Manguinhos has begun.
