Fiocruz trains professionals from 7 countries for the laboratory diagnosis of monkeypox



The initiative was promoted by the Pan-American Health Organization (PAHO/WHO), the Brazilian Ministry of Health and Fiocruz. Technicians from national health institutions of Bolivia, Ecuador, Colombia, Peru, Paraguay, Uruguay and Venezuela took part

Study shows levels of risk of epidemic or pandemic outbreak in Brazil



Deforestation and illegal hunting favor the country's performance as an incubator for the possible spread of disease of animal origin. A study led by researchers of the Oswaldo Cruz Institute and published in Science Advances points to recent increases in the country's social and ecological variabilities

Nísia Trindade Lima followed the debates of the assembly, in Geneva, Switzerland, with the theme Health for Peace, Peace for Health. The main decision-making agency of WHO defines the global health agenda based on decisions, agreements and collaborations

Fiocruz Mato Grosso do Sul and Sabin research fractionated booster dose of COVID-19 vaccine



The study will seek volunteers in areas with low vaccine coverage in the state capital. The research shall reveal if smaller doses can offer the same immunological response with fewer reactions

A new species of triatomine bugs has been described by a group led by scientists of the Oswaldo Cruz Institute (IOC/Fiocruz) and christened Panstrongylus noireaui. The finding was published in ZooKeys

COVID-19 kills two children under 5 years old every day in Brazil

According to 'Observa Infância', an initiative of Fiocruz, between January and June 13, the country recorded 291 disease deaths among children under 5
