## Rate of hospitalized babies due to malnutrition reaches its worst level in the past 13 years



A survey by Observa Infância shows that, in 2021, the number of hospitalizations of babies under one year old due to malnutrition reached the highest absolute number. By the end of August 2022, an increase of 7\% was recorded compared to 2021

## Anticoagulant Apixaban inhibits COVID-19 replication

Published in the 'Journal of Molecular Cell Biology', a new study by Fiocruz proved that the oral anticoagulant is effective in inhibiting the replication of the Sars-CoV-2 virus, the cause of the disease

Fiocruz releases management report for the past two years
The document offers a thorough picture of the efforts undertaken by the Foundation to offer quick responses to the Brazilian population in the fight against the public health emergency caused by the pandemic

Study shows a 70\% excess of maternal deaths in Brazil during the pandemic
In partnership with researchers from Colombia and the USA, a study coordinated by Fiocruz Amazônia pointed to a substantial increase in maternal deaths during the first 15 months of the pandemic
