President of Fiocruz signs Memorandum of Understanding with minitries in Portugal





Foundation and Chinese institution create center for disease prevention



The agreement was signed by the president of Fiocruz, Mario Moreira, and the director of the Institute of Microbiology, during President Lula's trip to China; the center will have headquarters both in Rio de Janeiro and Beijing

Study reveals that cells can be reprogrammed to fight breast cancer



At Fiocruz Minas Gerais, a team of researchers has shown that it is possible to prevent the growth of malignant breast tumors by altering the profile of one of the body's defense cell types, macrophages, using iron oxide nanoparticles

The mosquito biofactory will have an annual production capacity of up to 5 billion Wolbitos, as the 'Aedes aegypti' mosquitoes with the Wolbachia bacteria are known. Method reduces incidence of dengue, chikungunya and zika

BCG vaccine does not protect against COVID-19 in healthcare workers

A world-leading international trial into the immune-boosting benefits of the tuberculosis vaccine, BCG, the BRACE trial was led by Murdoch Children's Research Institute and published in the New England Journal of Medicine

Increase in malaria cases has a direct correlation with illegal mining

This is what a study conducted by the Oswaldo Cruz Institute (IOC/Fiocruz) in partnership with other institutions showed. The work was published in the Malaria Journal and analyzed data on the disease from 2010 to 2020
